dejected (adj)

to feel sad; to feel **thrown** down in spirit

eject (v)

to **throw** out

injection (n)

a shot; the "**throwing**" of medicine into the body by a needle

interjection (n)

a word **thrown** into a sentence or conversation

jettison (v)

to **throw** goods overboard to lighten the load on a boat or an airplane

projectile (n)

an object **thrown** into the air with great force

projector (n)

a machine that **throws** an image onto a wall

reject (v)

to **throw** something out because it's defective and can't be used again

subject (v)

to **throw** oneself under someone else's rule

trajectory (n)

the curved path of an object **thrown** into space
